HONORS PROGRAM ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FALL 2010

The Academic Excellence Scholarship is awarded annually to an entering Honors Program freshman who shows particular promise and interest in academic excellence, campus leadership and visibility, and a commitment to undergraduate research. While the amount of the award will vary, the scholarship is designed to make up the difference between the highest college-awarded scholarship and Westminster tuition. The theory behind the scholarship is to allow the recipient to devote the majority of his or her time to educational pursuits, as well as leadership and research opportunities. This annual scholarship is renewable for up to four years, provided the student maintains a 3.0 GPA, or better, and continues as a full-time student.

Eligible students are those admitted to the Honors Program with an ACT composite score of **30 or higher**. Interested candidates should fill out this application cover sheet completely, attach their typed essay (see below), and mail it with the completed Honors Program application by March 30, 2010, to Westminster College Admissions, 1840 South 1300 East, Salt Lake City, UT 84105. Scholarship Application Essay

The Honors Program Academic Excellence Scholarship is designed to reward a student who embodies the attributes of academic excellence, leadership, visibility, and commitment to research in a chosen field, and who encourages others to strive for similar goals. Write a short, typed essay that profiles a real person (living or dead) who demonstrates these characteristics. Give examples of how that individual's success was accelerated by the high standards she/he set for himself/herself. Describe how you plan to embody such attributes and how and why you plan to pursue them while a member of the Honors Program. Print your 1-3 page Scholarship Application essay, *keeping it separate from your Honors Program Admissions essay*, and attach it to this Honors Scholarship Application.

Your Honors Program application will not be affected in any way by whether or not you apply for this scholarship.
