

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE TO UNDERGRADUATE CONTINUING STUDENTS

NOTE: Full-time enrollment is 12 (or more) credit hours Fall and Spring semesters.

Half-time enrollment is 6 to 11 credit hours Fall and Spring semesters.

KIM T. ADAMSON ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$500)

Established in 1982 by Kim T. Adamson. Available to full-time students who have good academic records, and who show financial need. Preference given to sons and daughters of full-time law enforcement officers (municipal, state, or federal levels), or who have parents on active duty in the U.S. military.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

MOHAMMED BIN SAIF AL-JABRI (THE PEARL DIVER) SCHOLARSHIP – (One for \$3000)

Established in 2007 by family members, to honor Mohammed Bin Saif Al-Jabri, the Pearl Diver. Awarded to a deserving student with strong academic qualifications and financial need.

Requirement: at least a 3.00; full-time enrollment.

DR. JAMES D. ALLEN MEMORIAL FUND SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$1000)

Established in 1983 by Mabel D. Allen in memory of her son. Recipient must be a junior or senior in good standing specializing in English literature. Recipient must also be aware of Dr. James D. Allen's academic contributions by initially reviewing his biographical sketch on file in the Financial Aid Office.

Requirement: full-time enrollment.

ALLY BANK SCHOLARSHIP – (Two for \$2500)

Established by Ally Bank. Awarded to undergraduate student who are eligible for Federal Pell Grant.

Requirement: full-time enrollment

THE ANSELMO FAMILY NURSING SCHOLARSHIP – (One for \$1000)

Established in 2011 by Donna and Frank Anselmo. Recipient must be a junior or senior nursing student in good academic standing. Recipients must demonstrate financial need.

Requirement: at least a 3.30 GPA

ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP - (Four for \$1625)

Established in 1981 by the Westminster College Alumni Association. Four scholarships for students in the following categories: continuing part-time or full-time sophomores, juniors, or seniors. Each recipient must be related to an alumnus/ae of Westminster College, and indicate that relationship on the application. Activities in either on- or off-campus volunteer organizations are encouraged. Recipients must demonstrate financial need. Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; half-time enrollment.

GRETCHEN ANDERSON ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP – (One for \$1200)

Established in 2011 by Gretchen Anderson. Awarded to a female student who demonstrates financial need.

G.W. AND LEE ANDERSON ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP – (One for \$1000)

Established in 2006 by G.W. and Lee Anderson. Awarded to junior or senior nursing students who are in good academic standing and who have financial need.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

JAMES WILLIAM AND KATHERINE NICOL ANDREWS SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$1000)

Established in 1994 in memory of James William and Katherine Nicol Andrews. Awarded to an accounting or business major, with preference given to an accounting major who is a sophomore, junior or senior. Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

ARCHER FAMILY CHARITABLE CORPORATION ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$500)

Established in 2012 by Elizabeth A. Williams and the Archer Family Charitable Corporation. Awarded to a student who exhibits strong academic achievement and demonstrates financial need.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; half-time enrollment

SAMUEL S. AND MARY ALICE ARENTZ ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$1300) ✓

Established in 1997 by Samuel S. Arentz III and Cathy Arentz. Awarded to a Westminster College student who is active in campus music programs.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

BARBARA ARNOLD MEMORIAL ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (Four for \$2750)

Established in 1989 by Archibald Arnold and Dottie Bintz, to honor the memory of Mr. Arnold's wife, Barbara Arnold, who was a special education teacher. Awarded to education majors on the basis of academic achievement. Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

ISABELLE W. ARNOLD ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (Two for \$2500)

Established in 1998 by Isabelle W. Arnold. Awarded to sophomore, junior, or senior female students with high academic standing and financial need.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

ROBERT G. AND MARGARET Q. ARNOLD SCHOLARSHIP - (Nine for \$2000)

Established in 2003 by Mr. Robert Arnold. Awarded to sophomore, junior, or senior business majors who have strong liberal arts backgrounds.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; half-time enrollment.

JED ARVESETH SCHOLARSHIP – (One for \$1000)

Established in 2011 by Mary Lou and Allan Arveseth and the Arveseth family to honor the memory of A. Jed Arveseth, a graduate of Westminster College. Following an unprecedented write-in election in 1994, Jed served as president of the Westminster student body two years in succession overturning 120 years of tradition. Awarded to a student involved in Student Government who is in good academic standing and demonstrates financial need.

STEVE AND LOIS BAAR SCHOLARSHIP - (Two for \$1150)

Established in 2007 by family and friends of Steve and Lois Baar, to honor both of them and their years of service to Westminster College. Awarded to a student with a strong academic history at the college, who has a minor in an academic area totally different from her/his major.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

BAMBERGER FOUNDATION NURSING SCHOLARSHIP – (Eight for \$6,000)

Established in 2001 by the Bamberger Foundation. Awarded to junior or senior nursing majors who show academic excellence and demonstrated financial need.

Requirement: at least a 3.50 GPA; full-time enrollment.

BAMBERGER FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$1000)

A centennial gift from the Bamberger Foundation, endowing a scholarship for a talented business student who is a sophomore, junior or senior.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

KAREN S. BARNETT HONORS SCHOLARSHIP – (One for \$3000)

Established in 2007 by the estate of Marva T. Barnett. Awarded to junior or senior students in the college's Honors Program who have financial need, and who have a declared major in one or more of the following: art, biology, chemistry, English, environmental studies, history, mathematics, nursing, philosophy, physics, political studies, psychology.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

MICHAEL AND MARY BASSIS SCHOLARSHIP FUND – (One for \$3000)

Established in 2012 by the Westminster College community to commemorate the contributions of former President Michael Bassis and the equally selfless service of his wife, Mary. Awarded to a student who demonstrates financial need with preference given to individuals from underrepresented groups who participate in community service.

ROSS BEASON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR FULL-TIME STUDENTS - (Sixteen for \$2500)

Established in 1980 by the Ross Beason Trust. Awarded primarily on the basis of character and financial need. Requirement: full-time enrollment.

ROSS BEASON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR PART-TIME STUDENTS - (Four for \$1200)

Established in 1980 by the Ross Beason Trust. Awarded primarily on the basis of character and financial need. Requirement: half-time enrollment.

BECTON DICKINSON SCHOLARSHIP – (two for \$1000)

Established in 1990 to assist nursing students who are in their sophomore, junior or senior years and who demonstrate financial need.

Requirement: at least a 2.50 GPA; full-time enrollment

JACK AND NANCY BEHNKEN ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (Eight for \$2750)

Established in 1995 through an endowment funded by Jack and Nancy Behnken. Awarded to students on the basis of character, financial need, and academic achievement.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

PETER AND DAGMAR BEHRENS ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$1200)

Established in 1998 by Peter and Dagmar Behrens. Awarded on the basis of academic achievement.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; half-time enrollment.

IRENE BUNCH BELDEN MEMORIAL NURSING SCHOLARSHIP - (Twelve for \$2850)

Established by Galen Belden in 1991. Awarded to nursing students who have completed their freshman year and who demonstrate financial need.

Requirements: at least a 2.50 GPA; half-time enrollment.

DR. BRUCE BEMIS MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (Ten for \$1900)

Established in 1992 to honor Dr. Bruce Bemis, professor of mathematics, for his contributions to his students and colleagues at Westminster College. Awarded to juniors and seniors majoring in math, computer science or physical science who plan to pursue careers in those fields.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; half-time enrollment.

M. LYNN BENNION URBAN EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$4000)

Established in 1997 by the children of M. Lynn Bennion to assist students in the School of Education who will conduct their student teaching in urban schools. The scholarship is to be awarded to students in their student teaching year. Students receiving this scholarship must express a genuine interest in a career of teaching in inner city public schools. Recipients must be in strong academic standing and demonstrate financial need.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

OLIVE L. BERGER NURSING SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$2300)

Established in 1998 by Edward and Marjorie Brass to recognize students with high academic standing and financial need. Awarded to sophomore nursing students.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

KATHARINE V. BIELE NURSING SCHOLARSHIP – (Two for \$2500)

Established in 1995 by the family of Katharine V. Biele. Awarded to nursing students who have strong academic backgrounds.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

MICHAEL F.G. BILLS AND AMY KELLER-BILLS SCHOLARSHIP – (One for \$2000)

Established in 2012 by Michael F.G. Bills and Amy Keller-Bills. Michael received his MBA from Westminster College in 2004, participated in the Master Track program, taught as an adjunct business professor and is a member of the Board of Trustees. Amy is a locally renowned yoga instructor and former competitive gymnast. Awarded to a first generation college student in good academic standing.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

BRADSHAW FACULTY SCHOLARSHIP – (Four for \$2250)

Funded by the Berenice Jewett Bradshaw Endowment. Awarded to sophomores, juniors and seniors in each of the four schools (Arts and Sciences, Business, Nursing, and Education).

BROADWAY IN UTAH/MAGICSPACE ENTERTAINMENT SCHOLARSHIP - (Two for \$2500)

Established in 2012 by Broadway in Utah/MagicSpace Entertainment. Awarded to a theatre major in good academic standing.

Requirement: full-time enrollment.

HARRISON S. BROTHERS ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$2100)

Established in 1998 by the Henry and Leslie Eskuche Foundation and the family of Harrison S. Brothers, as a tribute to Mr. Brothers. Awarded to students who are leaders in their college and community.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

DIANE FORSTER-BURKE NURSING SCHOLARSHIP – (One for \$1500)

Established in 2007 by Diane Forster-Burke, a nursing professor on campus. Awarded to a junior or senior majoring in nursing that demonstrates a financial need and is working in nursing at least 20 hours/week. Requirement: GPA between 3.00 – 3.40.

R. HAROLD BURTON SCHOLARSHIP IN BUSINESS – (Two for \$15000)

Established in 2011 by the R. Harold Burton Foundation to continue the legacy of R. Harold Burton by supporting education, science, literary, and health projects in the greater Salt Lake Metropolitan area. Awarded to junior business students, per recommendation by the Gore School of Business, who intend to pursue careers in business and who demonstrate academic success and financial need. Recipient must be a U.S. citizen from the state of Utah. Recipient must also be aware of R. Harold Burton and his contributions by reviewing his biographical sketch on file in the Financial Aid Office.

Requirement: at least a 3.7 GPA; full-time enrollment

R. HAROLD BURTON SCHOLARSHIP IN NURSING – (Two for \$15000)

Established in 2011 by the R. Harold Burton Foundation to continue the legacy of R. Harold Burton by supporting education, science, literary, and health projects in the greater Salt Lake Metropolitan area. Awarded to junior nursing students, per recommendation by the School of Nursing, who intend to pursue careers in nursing and who demonstrate academic success and financial need. Recipient must be a U.S. citizen from the state of Utah. Recipient must also be aware of R. Harold Burton and his contributions by reviewing his biographical sketch on file in the Financial Aid Office.

Requirement: at least a 3.7 GPA; full-time enrollment

CALVERT FAMILY ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP – (One for \$1000)

Established in 2005 from a gift by Hayden Morgan Calvert. Awarded to a junior or senior who are married or a single parent who is working full or part time while attending classes. Recipients must demonstrate financial need. Requirement: at least 2.50 GPA.

LYLE AND MARJORIE CAMPBELL ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$1500)

Established in 1998 by Lyle and Marjorie Campbell and Wheeler Machinery Company. Awarded to sophomore, junior, or senior students based on academic achievement, with preference to students who show financial need. Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

KIM CASADAY SCHOLARSHIP – (one for \$1000)

Established in 2014 by Kim Casaday, Alumna class of 2002 at Westminster College. Awarded female business majors, which preference given to those who show financial need.

Requirement: full-time enrollment

DON-KAY-CLAY CASH FOUNDATION ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$1200)

Established in 1998 by The Don-Kay-Clay Cash Foundation. Awarded to a student pursuing a degree in engineering, science, or business, and who show financial need.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; half-time enrollment.

CASTLE FOUNDATION NURSING ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (Two for \$2500)

Established in 2000 by the Castle Foundation. Awarded to a sophomore, junior, or senior nursing student who is a Utah resident, from a low to moderate income family, and who is a minority student.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

FREDERICK W. CHAMP SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$1500)

Established in 2002 by the estate of Frederick W. "Wint" Champ. Awarded to business majors.

JPMORGAN CHASE BANK ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (Two for \$1250)

Established in 1998 by Chase Bank (formerly Bank One Utah). Awarded to a business major, on the basis of academic achievement and financial need.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

CHENEY GOLF SCHOLARHIP – (One for \$500)

Established in 2012 by Brian Cheney. Recipients must be athletes on the Men's Golf Team and have good academic achievement. The award will be decided by financial aid with input from the golf coach.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

CHIVAS REGAL YOUNG ENTREPRENEUR SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$500)

Established in 1988 by a gift from The House of Seagram. Applicants must be business majors, and at least 21 years of age as of January 1, 2013.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

DR. DEAN K. AND HELEN S. CHRISTENSEN ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$1800)

Established in 1995. Awarded to a female nursing student. Recipient must be a single parent.

Requirement: at least a 2.50 GPA; full-time enrollment.

WILLIAM CLARK ACCOUNTING PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$3000)

Established in 1985 by the accounting faculty to memorialize William Clark, former business manager of the college, and to recognize outstanding accounting students. Recipients must be juniors or seniors majoring in accounting, and must show financial need.

Requirement: at least a 3.50 GPA; half-time enrollment.

CLASS OF 1987 SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$1000)

Established as a gift from the Westminster College class of 1987. Awarded to a sophomore, junior, or senior student who demonstrates financial need, with preference given to a student who has special needs (specifically physical limitations such as hearing impairment, mobility, loss of sight).

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

CLASS OF 2004 SCHOLARSHIP - (Two for \$750)

Awarded to upperclassmen who have financial need.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment

KATHRYN KYRIOPOULOS COLEMERE ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (Two for \$1500)

Established in 2004 by Ms. Colemere. Awarded to students who are single parents who have demonstrated financial need. Peference given to students in business, education, or nursing majors.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; half-time enrollment.

COLLEGE CLUB SCHOLARSHIP - (Two for \$1500)

Provided by the members of the College Club to assist senior women with their college costs. Recipients must exemplify character and an interest in community activities.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

AMANDA COLLER MEMORIAL EDUCATION ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (Three for \$5000)

Established in 2000 by Clyde and Marilyn Coller, to honor Amanda Coller. Awarded to an education major who has an excellent academic record.

Requirement: at least a 3.50 GPA; full-time enrollment.

LISA COLLET EXCEPTIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP – (One for \$1000)

Established in 2012 by Corbin W. Archer in dedication to his wife, Lisa Collet Archer. The Westminster College community shares her husband's deep appreciation to Lisa for her grace and selflessness which enables Corbin, a 2002 Westminster MBA graduate and the President of the Westminster Alumni Board (2011-2013), to dedicate countless hours to the betterment of the college. Awarded to a student who demonstrates a genuine appreciation and passion for Westminster College, as well as a strong desire to remain enrolled at the college as determined by the Director of Financial Aid. Preference will be given to a student athlete.

Requirement: at least a 2.50 GPA; full-time enrollment

THOMAS SPENCER COLTON SCHOLARSHIP - (Four for \$2500)

Established in 1998 in the name of Thomas Spencer Colton, a Westminster College alumnus. Awarded to liberal arts majors, or students who have a humanities emphasis, and have demonstrated interest in public service. Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA, full-time enrollment.

COMENITY CAPITAL BANK SCHOLARSHIP – (Two for \$1250)

Established in 2011. Awarded to business students who are Pell eligible with good academic standing. Requirement: Full-time enrollment

TOMMY CONNOR LEADERSHIP AWARD – (One for \$5000)

Established in 2012 to honor Tommy Connor, the Director of Athletics for the college from 2000-2005 and the Men's Basketball Head Coach from 1998-2011 who guided the team to a 264-114 record during his 12 seasons. Connor was a five-time Frontier Conference Coach of the Year, and his teams qualified for nine NAIA National Tournament appearances. Awarded to a sophomore, junior or senior student in good academic standing who is on the roster of the Men's Basketball team.

Requirement: full-time enrollment

ANNICE LYMAN COTTRELL SCHOLARSHIP – (One for \$1000)

Established in 2012 by William Cottrell. Awarded to a single female student in good academic standing majoring in social sciences, humanities or other liberal arts curricula who demonstrate financial need. Preference given to a single female student raised in the Sugarhouse area of Salt Lake City.

COUNCIL FOR THE INVESTMENT IN EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$1000)

Established in 2012 by the Council for the Investment of Education. Awarded to an education major, with preference given to a creative arts minor, who is in good academic standing and demonstrates financial need. Requirement: full-time enrollment.

DAVID CUCH SCHOLARSHIP – (one for \$3000)

Established in 2007 in memory of David Cuch, an alumnus of Westminster College. Awarded to Native American students.

Requirement: full-time enrollment

DAUGHTERS OF MINOS SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$900)

Established by the Daughters of Minos, Delta Mu Chapter of the Greek Orthodox Church. Applicants must be Utah residents, of Greek descent (preference given to those of Cretan descent), and active in the Greek Orthodox Church. Sophomore, junior, or senior class standing is required.

Requirement: at least a 2.30 GPA; full-time enrollment.

RONALD W. AND TRACEY B. DAW ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$400)

Established in 1998 by Ronald W. and Tracey B. Daw. Awarded to students based on academic achievement and financial need.

Requirement: at least a 3.50 GPA; half-time enrollment.

LAWRENCE T. AND JANET T. DEE ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (Two for \$2250)

Established in 2000 by the Lawrence T. and Janet T. Dee Foundation. Awarded to education majors who are planning careers as elementary or secondary teachers, on the basis of academic achievement, financial need, and personal integrity.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

DON DOXEY ART SCHOLARSHIP – (Two for \$2000)

Established in 2012 by Richard and Enid Wood to honor professor Don Doxey who taught at Westminster College from 1961 to 1994. Don Doxey's skill as a teacher was as masterful as his skill as a painter. While insisting always on excellence, he was unfailingly generous, kind and supportive. Awarded to sophomore, junior or senior art students who show financial need.

Requirement: half-time enrollment.

WILLIAM H. AND JEANNE E. DUMAS SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$1600)

Established in 1995 by the Dumas family. Awarded to students who show financial need.

Requirement: half-time enrollment.

DEBRA RAE DUNCAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP – (one for \$1200)

Established in 2013 by Trudy and Ed Duncan in memory of Debra Rae Duncan. Awarded to students majoring in nursing.

Requirement: full-time enrollment

SUE A. AND FREDERICK C. DUTHWEILER SCHOLARSHIP – (eight for \$1375)

Established in 2013 by Sue Ashurst Duthweiler and Frederick C. Duthweiler. Awarded to students majoring in the physical sciences with preference given to those demonstrating financial need. Requirement: full-time enrollment

THE PATRICIA DOUGALL EAGER ENDOWED SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP – (seven at \$2000)

Established by Mrs. Patricia Eager. Awarded to science majors who plan to teach, with preference given to students who are engaged in undergraduate research.

Requirement: full-time enrollment

MARRINER S. ECCLES FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP – (Four for \$5000)

Funded by the Marriner S. Eccles Foundation since 2000. Awarded to full-time undergraduate students who have very strong records of academic achievement, and financial need.

Requiremennt: at least a 3.70 GPA; full-time enrollment.

KATHERINE A. ELLIS SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$1000)

Established in 2015 by Katherine A. Ellis, awarded to female accounting students, with preference given to single mothers and/or demonstrate financial need.

Requirement: full-time enrollment

ENERGYSOLUTIONS SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP – (Three for \$2500)

Established in 2011 by EnergySolutions. Awarded to sophomore students majoring in math, chemistry, physics, biology or environmental studies who intend to pursue careers in science and/or math. This scholarship may be retained from year to year if the student continues the successful pursuit of a science career.

Requirement: Full-time enrollment

LESLIE ESKUCHE NURSING ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (Two for \$2500)

Established in 1983 through the Leslie M. Eskuche Trust. Awarded to sophomore, junior, or senior nursing students. Requirement: at least a 2.50 GPA; full-time enrollment.

LESLIE ESKUCHE ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP - (Two for \$2000)

Awarded to sophomore, junior, or senior students who have achieved academic excellence.

Requirement: at least a 3.00 GPA; full-time enrollment.

EUREKA CASINO RESORT WOUNDED WARRIOR SCHOLARSHIP – (one for \$2000)

Established by Eureka Casino Resort. Awarded to students who are a veteran, which preference going to a wounded veteran. Preference to students who show financial need.

Requirement: at least a 2.5 GPA

GENE AND MAXINE FALKENRATH ENTREPRENEUR SCHOLARSHIP - (One for \$1000)

Established in 2012 by Rex Falkenrath and Amy Paul. Gene Falkenrath, a Westminster alum, earned his pilot's license at age 14 and never stopped reaching for the sky. Maxine Falkenrath, known as "the voice of reason" to shareholders, supported her husband's entrepreneurial endeavors with her keen financial skills. Together they had four sons Ray, Rex, Jack and Craig whom they supported and mentored in entrepreneurship. Both Gene and Maxine served as founders and as members of the board of directors of multiple corporations and partnerships. Awarded to business students seeking an entrepreneurship certificate, with recommendation from the Director of the Center for Entrepreneurship, with preference given to students engaged in creating or running their own business.

THE FANG FAMILY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP
